PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

On Wednesday, August 30th, the Economic Development Commission sponsored another Business Networking Breakfast for local businesses, held at the Douglas Library. The main speakers for the event were our elected State officials, Senator Cathy Osten, and Representative Robin Green, who provided an update on the state budget negotiations and other legislation from the 2017 session. They provided timely and in depth information on State legislative actions. The Planning and Zoning Commission continued their review of the Comprehensive Update to the Hebron Zoning Regulations at their last meeting held on August 15th. They are reviewing a draft compiled by Glenn Chalder of Planimetrics following up on numerous workshop sessions. A Public Information Meeting is planned this Fall.

The Planning and Zoning Commission at their August meeting approved a building addition to 27 Main Street, the offices of Dr. Myriah Hinchey, to accommodate the growing services offered by her business, TaoVitality, a Naturopathic wellness clinic located on Main Street.

PUBLIC WORKS

This week the Public Works Department installed a new drainage pipe on Grayville Road to eliminate a shoulder hazard. The seasonal banners were changed at the Town buildings to the Maple Leaf emblem. Roadside mowing continues throughout Town. Tree trimming and removals were conducted on East Street. Two of our larger trucks were sent to Hartford to have broken springs repaired. The pavement treatment for Charles Lane, Joel Drive, Ridge Road, Village Lane and Cottage Lane was started by the application of a chip stone surface. The loose stones will be swept next week and this will be followed up in two weeks by an additional sealing treatment. CNG is completing its installation on Church Street and is presently installing the service to the Senior Center.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Last week we hosted our annual American Red Cross blood drive with 48 donors.

On Monday, the Fire department took delivery of its new SCBA (self-contained breathing apparatus).

We are continuing fair preparation.
