**PUBLIC WORKS**

This week the Public Works Department worked on drainage upgrades to Grayville Road and replacing pipe and catch basins on Old Colchester Road. Roadside mowing continues throughout Town as vegetation continues to grow and site lines need to be cleared. Top soiling to back up the paving on Hillcrest Drive took place and pothole patching was needed on Paper Mill Road and Old Andover Road. The chip stone was swept on the cape sealing projects on Charles Lane, Joel Drive, Ridge Road, Cottage Lane and Village Lane. The final coating is scheduled to be placed at the end of next week. Tree Trimming was conducted on East Street, Deepwood Drive, and Indian Field Road. The crew assisted at the Hebron Fair with mowing and sweeping throughout the Fairgrounds.
