**TOWN MANAGER:**

On April 5, 2018, the Hebron Board of Selectmen established a nine (9) member Charter Revision Commission. The Board is seeking volunteers who are electors within the Town of Hebron to serve on the Charter Revision Commission.

Those people volunteering to be on the Commission must be willing to commit to attending nearly all meetings of the Commission and should have some familiarity with the Town and municipal government.
