This week the Public Works Department started the week by clearing leaves from drainage right of ways for heavy rains on Monday. Parking lots were staked, and catch basin locations were marked in preparation for the winter season. The crew exposed and cleared drainage pipes at the library to help resolve water issues. Crack-sealing was conducted this week as a pavement treatment on miscellaneous roads. A culvert on Congress Drive had to be cleared of beaver debris that caused drainage to back up. Roadside vegetation clearing took place on Niles road and Wellington Way. Litter was removed from the roadside throughout town. One employee attended Electrical Hazard Training at Eversource to improve our bucket truck safety skills.
