

3rd Hebron Creates Show
Gilead School
November 6, 2010, 10 AM to 4 PM
Application Due September 7, 2010

Eligibility: The show is open to all artists from Hebron and the surrounding towns (Andover, Bolton, Colchester, Columbia, Glastonbury, Lebanon, and Marlborough), who wish to display their work in the field of Fine Arts, Crafts and Literature. The Show will be held at the Gilead School, 580 Gilead Street, Hebron.

Rules:

- **Work for Display:** All displayed work must be original work, created by the artist. Reproductions must be labeled as such. The Show Committee may disallow the exhibition or sale of any item, which in the opinion of the Committee, is considered detrimental to the good public image of the Show or does not comply with the Show rules.
- **Attendance:** The exhibiting artist must be present and the booth must be open during all hours of the show. Dealers, agents or artist representatives are not allowed. If the artist is opening their home studio, the artist must be present and remain open during the hours of the show.
- **Exhibit Space:** Each booth is approximately 6 x 10 feet. A 6 foot table is available for each exhibit space if needed, otherwise exhibitors should provide their own display setups. No tents or canopies are allowed. The Show Committee will assign booth space.

Exhibitor Responsibilities:

- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their art and display. Hebron Creates and its Show Committee assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any artwork or display, or for any personal injury. Please keep your space tidy. Pets are not allowed.
- Exhibitors must have a valid Connecticut Sales Tax Identification Number. To apply for a Tax Number, contact: Department of Revenue Services, 25 Sigourney Street, Hartford, CT 06106. 860-297-5962 To download an application from the internet, go to www.drs.state.ct.us. If you do not have a CT tax ID number, apply for one and note on the Show application your ID is pending.
- **Cancelation Policy:** If you cancel before September 21, we will return your application fee. There will be no refunds after September 21.
- **Set-up and Breakdown:** Exhibitors may set up their booths from 5 to 7 pm on Friday, November 5, or after 8 am on Saturday, November 6. Booths must be

ready by 10 am. Exhibitors may not breakdown their displays before 4 pm on the Show day.

Media Definitions: These are the media definitions used to jury acceptance into the Show.

Art Media

Oil – work created with traditional oils, alkyds or oil sticks

Acrylic – work created with acrylic media

Watercolor – work created with watercolor media

Pastel – work created with soft or oil pastel

Drawing – work created with pen/ink, charcoal, conte, colored pencil, etc.

Mixed Media – 2-D work created with a combination of art materials and media

Sculpture – 3-D non-functional work created with one material or combination of materials

Prints – hand-pulled original works created from traditional methods such as etchings, silkscreens, monoprints, etc.

Photography – prints handmade by the artist in the darkroom or via digital/graphics

Graphics – works created from the artist's original source material via traditional means or digitally

Craft Media

Ceramics – work created in clay or porcelain – no molds or greenware allowed

Jewelry – wearable works created with precious stones, metals, enamel, clay, etc. – no mass produced techniques allowed

Fiber – decorative, functional or wearable work created using fiber – no ready made clothing allowed, no resale of kit items

Wood – original hand tooled, carved or machine-worked functional items in which the primary material is wood

Metal – original hand-worked, functional formed items in which the primary material is metal

Glass – works in which the primary material is glass

Mixed Media – 2-D and 3-D works created by the artist using a combination of media or materials, including dried floral creations

Original Work Only, no Buy/Sell allowed in any Art or Craft Medium

Schedule:

Applications must be received by September 7.

Applicants will be juried by the show committee and notified of acceptance on a first come first selected basis.

Applications received after September 7 will be considered after all other on-time applications are juried and only if space is available. We will maintain a small waiting list in case there are cancellations.
