Scholarship Program

Any Hebron resident may apply for a scholarship for a recreation program due to financial need. Requests must be made in writing on an official application form, available in the Parks & Recreation Office. All requests are confidential and will be evaluated based on financial or personal hardship.

Refund Programs:

Refunds are issued only in the following circumstances:

- If a program is cancelled by the Parks & Recreation Department.
- On request for a medical reason and with written notification from a doctor.
- If a program participant's spot can be replaced with someone from a waiting list.
- There are no refunds once a class has begun. (see Bus Trips below)
- All program cancellations and changes are subject to a \$15.00 fee.
- There is a \$20.00 fee for returned checks.

Parks and Recreation Enrichment Program "PREP"

PREP - Parks & Recreation Enrichment Program - continues to offer before and after school care for Hebron children in grades PRE K (3 or 4 year olds on or before December 31st of the current school year) 6th grade. Our goal at "PREP" is to provide a supportive, nurturing environment in which school-age children can develop socially, emotionally, and physically, by encouraging positive self-esteem, self-respect, and problem-solving skills. At PREP children engage in arts & crafts activities, team building games, sports, cooking and outside time weather permitting. Snack is provided to children at the PREP program. In the AM Care session the staff to child ratio is 1 staff member for every 6 children. In the PM Care session the ratio is 1 staff for every 7 children. The PREP staffs are First Aid, CPR and Blood Borne Pathogens certified.






