DEPARTMENT NEWS:

LIBRARY:

On Saturday, we hosted two Earth Day programs put together by the Green Committee (Compost and Beekeeping 101). The Green Garden Gang came out as a part of the wider town cleanup to further beautify the building's exterior after the work the town did a few weeks ago. We also planted a lilac bush for recently passed previous director Anne Bergan to the left of our main entrance.

We had 4072 visitors, circulated 4156 items and added 21 new users in April.

SENIOR CENTER:

ZUMBA Gold—Classes Tues & Thurs—10:10—11:10

This next session will begin Tuesday, May 7 through Thursday, May 30th. This is a 2 time per week class. There will be 8 classes in this session and the **cost will be \$16.** To register come to the center or call 860-228-1700.

Enhance Fitness—Mondays, Tuesdays, & Thursdays 9:00—10:00am

This class will focus on dynamic cardiovascular exercise, strength training, balance, and flexibility. Being this class is an evidence based program, the class will meet 3 times per week to increase the participants fitness gains. People who regularly attend class have proven to grow stronger, improve their balance, become more limber, and elevate mood. The class will meet Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00am—10:00am. Each session will be a 16 class session and will cost \$32. **The next new session begins Monday, May 6th and will run through Tuesday, June 11th. There will be 16 sessions for \$32.**

ACTIVE Fitness (formerly called Men’s Strength and Fitness Class)

We have renamed the Men’s Fitness Class to ACTIVE—Agility, Core, Toning, Improving health, Vibrancy, Energy. This class is perfect for both men and women who are looking to improve overall strength, core strength, balance, and overall fitness. This differs from Enhance Fitness by being 15 minutes shorter and having less of a cardio component. The class will be taught by Paul Smith and will meet on **Wednesday’s and Friday’s from 11:20-12:05**. The next class session will begin **Friday, May 10th and run through Friday, May 31st. No class Wednesday, May 8th—Parking lot scheduled to be paved**. This session will have 7 classes and cost \$14. To register or for more information call 860-228-1700.

We will begin offering “Adventure Outing” Programs this summer that are for the adventurous folks who like to hike, kayak, explore, participate in active outing trips, etc. This meeting is to tell you more about it, what’s already planned, and get ideas from you. ASSESSOR’S OFFICE:

The filing period for applications for the Elderly/Totally Disabled program is coming to an end fast. The office has sent out renewal applications and reminder notices for those that are required to re-file for this program, and for the Additional Veteran programs. The filing period goes from February 1 through May 15. Anyone that feels they may qualify and are not yet on the program are welcome to contact the office for information. The Additional Veteran program filing period ends October 1, 2019. A reminder that your Honorable Discharge papers (DD214) must be filed with the Town Clerk by October 1, 2019 to receive any Veteran Exemptions.

Now that warmer weather is here, we've started doing inspections on work completed for improvements to properties that applied for permits on or after October 2, 2018. If an interior inspection is required, the property owner will receive a letter in the mail requesting they contact this office to set up a date and time that would be convenient for them to have the inspection done. Any permit for exterior work, such as a deck or shed, we will visit the property collect the data and leave a notice on either the main entrance door, secondary door, or garage door, whichever is most accessible, notifying the owner that we were there. These improvements will affect the October 1, 2019 Grand List which will generate bills for July 2020.

Reminder for a motor vehicle that had been sold, junked, totaled or registered out of state after October 2, 2018. The bills that will be coming out in July 2019 are for vehicles registered from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. If you got rid of a vehicle and canceled the license plates any time during this assessment year, in order to have your bill pro-rated we need copies of the canceled plate receipt **and** some form of documentation as to what happened to the vehicle such as a bill of sale; note the DMV DOES NOT notify this office when the license plates have been canceled.
