DEPARTMENT NEWS:

LIBRARY:

The library held a successful evacuation and Overdrive training with nearly the entire staff on Friday.

Programs for the last week include an informational session about Canine genetics, a Friday movie, and the regular meeting of the Knitwits.

I also met with Bibliomation's Finance Committee, the schools' Innovation Advisory Council, and the Health and Safety Committee.

TOWN CLERK:

The electrical project for the Old Records Building to connect the electrical system to the Horton House is in progress. The electrician will make the connection as soon as he is able to. Switching this electrical service will be cost saving as well as offer better protection of the records in this building.

The Town budget referendum took place on Tuesday May 7th and all questions regarding the next fiscal year passed. Election reports for the state have been submitted and now we are preparing for the November election.

Preparations for dog licensing season has begun. The supplies have been ordered and received and we are meeting with our vender, Kofile, to make sure the program properly prints the post card reminder notices and dog licenses. Each dog owner with a current license will get a reminder notice in the mail with instructions for re-licensing.

The 19th Annual Hebron #1 Top Dog contest has officially started. Our local dog owners are invited to send us a photo of their dog which will be posted at the Russell Mercer Senior Center. The voting will be by paper ballot from May 13th through May 28th and the winner will be announced on May 29th.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

This week the Public Works Department worked on repairing drainage in preparation for new pavement on Crouch Road. This should be taking place the last week of May. Spring sweeping continues throughout town. The Senior Center parking lot was paved this week in the area of the new drainage installation. Wood Acres Road was prepped for paving by raising catch basins and manholes. This project is being done in coordination with the Town of Colchester and we are waiting on a schedule from the contractor. Wood debris was removed from the roadside where Eversource conducted tree removals at the request of the Town.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

This past week we responded to 11 EMS, 3 service calls and 1 motor vehicle accident.

SENIOR CENTER:

ZUMBA Gold—Classes Tues & Thurs—10:10—11:10

Enhance Fitness—Mondays, Tuesdays, & Thursdays 9:00—10:00am

This class will focus on dynamic cardiovascular exercise, strength training, balance, and flexibility. Being this class is an evidence based program, the class will meet 3 times per week to increase the participants fitness gains. People who regularly attend class have proven to grow stronger, improve their balance, become more limber, and elevate mood. The class will meet Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00am—10:00am. Each session will be a 16 class session and will cost \$32. **The next new session begins Monday, May 6th and will run through Tuesday, June 11th. There will be 16 sessions for \$32.**

ACTIVE Fitness (formerly called Men’s Strength and Fitness Class)

We have renamed the Men’s Fitness Class to **ACTIVE—Agility, Core, Toning, Improving health, Vibrancy, Energy.** This class is perfect for both men and women who are looking to improve overall strength, core strength, balance, and overall fitness. This differs from Enhance Fitness by being 15 minutes shorter and having less of a cardio component. The class will be taught by Paul Smith and will meet on **Wednesday’s and Friday’s from 11:20-12:05.** The next class session will begin **Friday, May 10th and run through Friday, May 31st. No class Wednesday, May 8th—Parking lot scheduled to be paved.** This session will have 7 classes and cost \$14. To register or for more information call 860-228-1700.
