

Hebron Resident Trooper

The Hebron Resident Trooper's Office is located at 44 Main St., inside Station #1 of the Hebron Fire Department.

The office is under the direction of Troop K within the Connecticut State Police. The Resident Trooper is directly supervised by the Troop K Resident Trooper Sergeant, currently Sgt. Joshua Woodward.

The Resident Trooper's primary function is providing police services to the Town of Hebron and supplement Troop K for emergencies when requested.





Hebron Police

Hebron Police is a constabulary system where the Officers use the infrastructure and command staff of the State Police to assist with providing the Town of Hebron police services.

Hebron Officers are employed by the Town of Hebron and supervised by the Resident Trooper who reports to the Town Manager who supervises the employment aspects of the Officers

Provide Police services within the Town of Hebron.






What does the Office provide the Town of Hebron?



3 Officers providing 12 hours each/ week coverage

1 Officer is full time during the day at RHAM as SRO (split between 2 officers currently)

1 Officer provides coverage in morning at HES for traffic everyday. (Split with BOE/ Patrol hours totaling 4 hrs)

Same officer continues to work on days in town towards their 12 hrs.

As schedule allows they work additional evening hours as well as weekend hours to help cover town

Town Manager has authorized additional hours as needed off hours of my schedule.

At all times Hebron is covered by Troop K Troopers. 1 assigned to cover Hebron/ Marlborough along w/ RT 2 from Glastonbury to Colchester


