PUBLIC NOTICE: OLD COLCHESTER ROAD BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION

Dear Hebron Residents of Old Colchester, Wood Pond, Pepperbush, and Heron Hill,

I am pleased to inform you that the Town's contractor will begin improvements/construction to the Old Colchester Road Bridge over Raymond Brook, in your area.

This is a multi-stage project that can result in various contractors for bridge replacement construction. This process from start to finish may span over the course of the 2026 construction season (weather permitting).

Public Works asks for your cooperation as follows:

- 1) Beginning April 7th, please avoid parking on the street during the hours of 6:00am-6:00pm, Monday through Friday, during the construction period. (Contractor will not be here on holidays)
- 2) Please limit your use of the roadway between Northam and Niles Road as much as possible. There will be a detour route implemented beginning 4/13/26 and will remain until the completion of the project. Residents who live in the blocked off area will still be able to exit and enter their driveways. RHAM, Hebron Public Schools and the bus company have been notified. Please stay updated on the school's response/plan for the detour routes.
- 3) Refuse and recycling schedules will continue to operate on their normal schedules. All-Waste and Casella have been made aware of the detour.
- 4) Please drive no more than 10mph to reduce flying dust.
- 5) Children must not enter the work zone or touch any equipment or supplies. Safety is our number one concern.
- 6) The airline trail will remain open for the duration of the project, but expect minor delays when crossing and please use caution.
